- Engage men in Christian fellowship with other men through Prayer, Bible Study, Worship, Small Group Interaction, and Ministry Activities

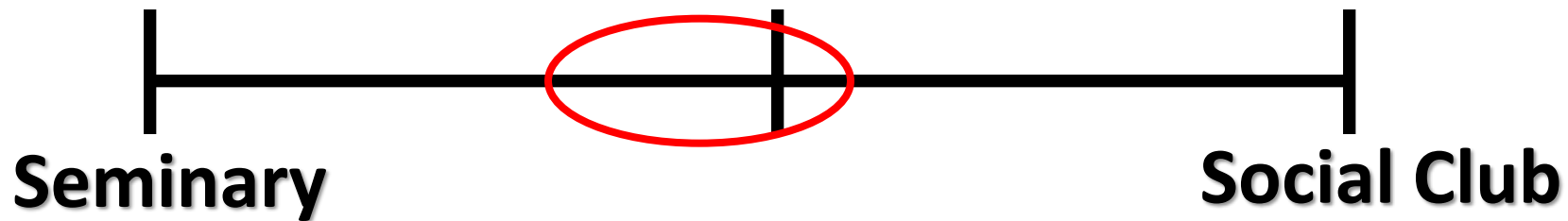
CORE COMPETENCIES

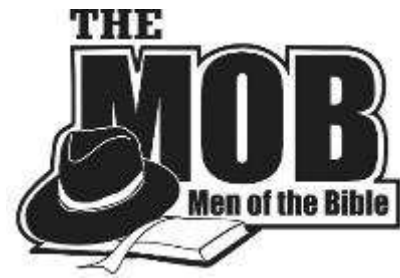

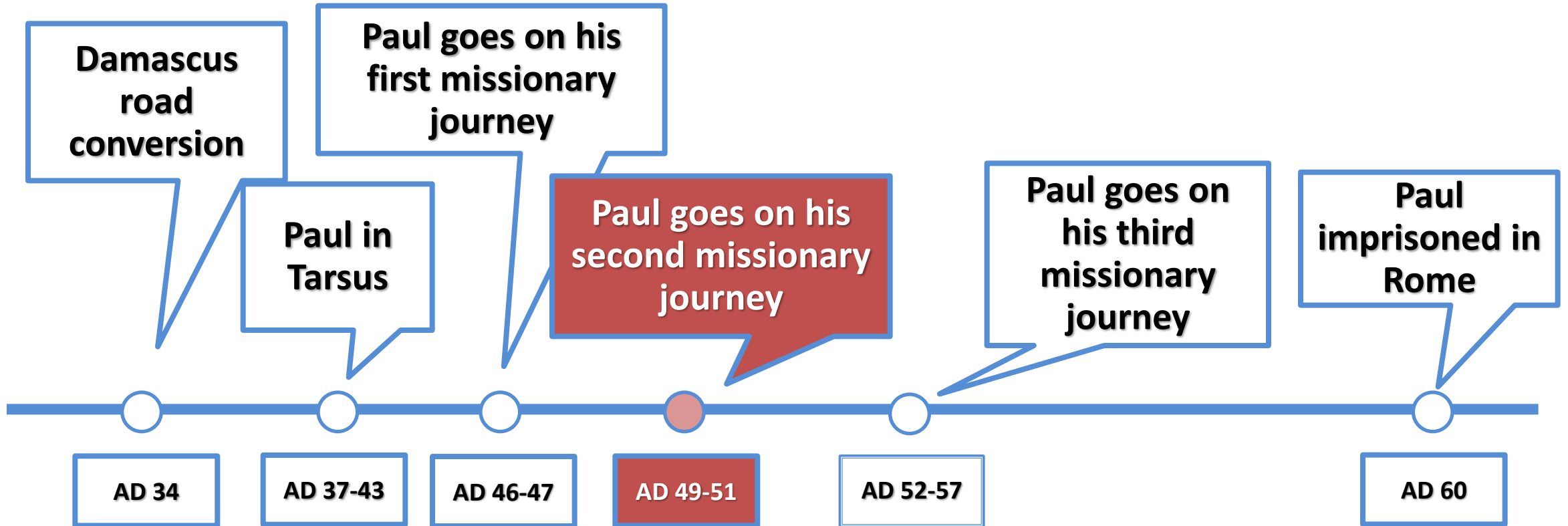
First Corinthians has much to say to IBC’s MOB!

Paul departs Athens and arrives in Corinth.

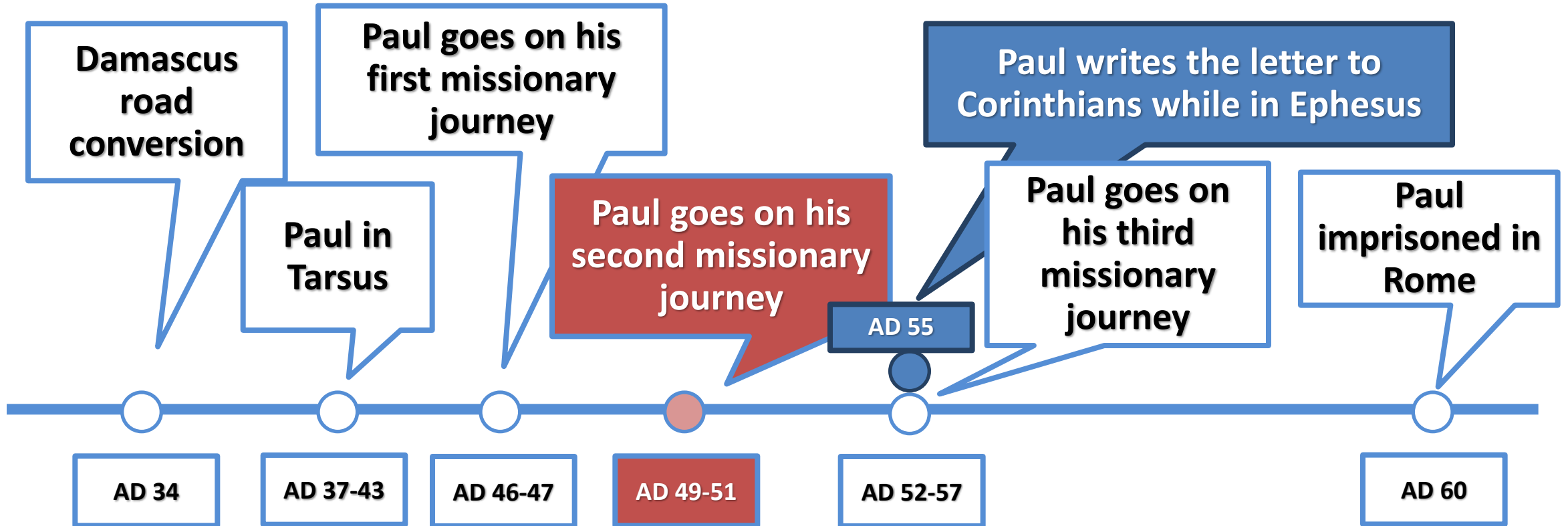
First Corinthians

Paul established the Church in Corinth.

- **Acts 18:5, “Paul was occupied with the word, testifying to the Jews that the Christ was Jesus.”**
- **Acts 18:8, “And many of the Corinthians hearing Paul believed and were baptized.”**
- **Acts 18:11, “And he stayed a year and six months, teaching the word of God among them.”**

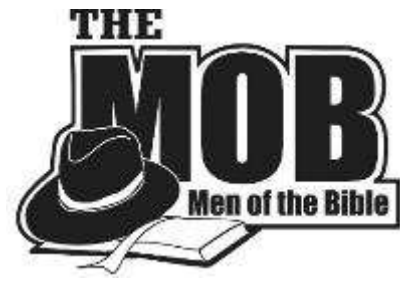

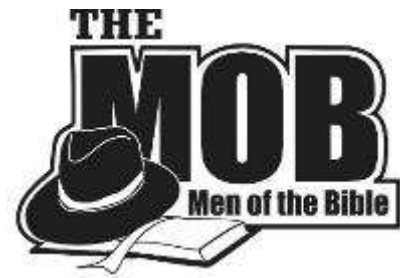

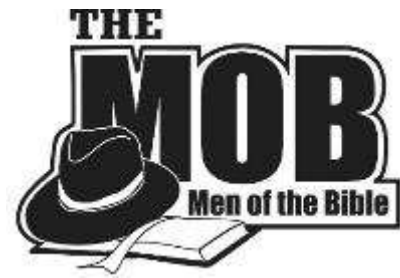
