
The Tribulation Experience


Tribulation – past, but fresh in experience, so praise for YHWH's deliverance

When you receive reproaches for His name –


View them from God's perspective

Do you follow this example to seek Him "diligently"? -- When it comes to your relationship with God, don't be sloppy or lazy or just do the minimum possible.




Trust in YHWH (26:10)



Resurrection ?? (26:14,19)




¹⁴ The dead will not live, the departed spirits will not rise; Therefore You have punished and destroyed them, And You have wiped out all remembrance of them.




A Speculative Future Map


Contrast this to the vineyard of Isaiah 5:1-7.

But it grew only STINK-FRUIT, so YHWH laid it waste.




Divine Restraint (27:7-8)




⁷ Has he struck them as he struck those who struck them?
Or have they been slain as their slayers were slain?
⁸ Measure by measure, by exile you contended with them; he removed them with his fierce breath in the day of the east wind. (ESV)

The Lord has never been as harsh with Israel as he has been with its foes (7); scattering ('by shooing away and sending her off') rather than destruction has been its portion (8). This same divine forbearance will yet be shown in a work of atonement to which Israel will respond by rejecting all false religion. (Motyer)



Harvest Time (27:12)




In that day from the river Euphrates to the Brook of Egypt the LORD will thresh out the grain, and you will be gleaned one by one, O people of Israel.



Reminiscent of Jesus parable of the wheat and the tares - burn the weeds, collect the wheat. (Matthew 13:24-30, 36-43)



These verses provide a fitting climax to chs. 24— 27 with their emphasis upon God's sovereignty over the nations and his intention to restore his people from the nations. (Oswalt)

The Jubilee trumpet (Lv. 25:9) was sounded on the Day of Atonement, linking verses 13 and 9 of the present passage. [V.9, Jacob's iniquity will be forgiven.]




Isaiah 25

- 1. Verse 1, sounding like a psalm, praises God for executing His "plans formed long ages ago." What plans did God have and when (prior to Isaiah's time) did He express them?
- 2. What is the city that is destroyed in verse 2? Why is that important here?
- 3. Verse 6 promises that YHWH of hosts will prepare a "lavish" banquet for all people. What do we know about this banquet?
- 4. The people at Mount Zion are in jaw-dropping awe. What are they coming to understand? (v9)






Isaiah 27

- 3. Verses 12-13 describe the great return/ingathering of the Lord's people. What stands out to you?
- 4. In the Millennium, God's covenants with Abraham and with David were fulfilled. What is the significance of that?
