| | a. | Observation : What do the Scripture passages say? |
| | | (1) Where is Jesus and His disciples at the start of this Scripture passage? |
| | | (2) Who will Jesus (God the Son) send from God the Father to be with His disciples? |
| | | (3) What will His role be (i.e., what are some of the things He will do)? |
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| | | (4) Who else will bear witness to who Jesus is and why? |
| | | (5) Why did Jesus say these things to His disciples? |
| | | (6) Why is it to our advantage that Jesus (God the Son) return to God the Father? |
| | | (7) What analogy did Jesus use to clarify His statements to the disciples? |
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(8) What was Jesus' promise to His disciples concerning their sorrow and distress?

- b. **Interpretation**: What does the Scripture passage mean?
 - (1) Why would Jesus' disciples "weep and lament"?
 - (2) **Why** would "the world" rejoice?
 - (3) Why will God the Father respond to the prayers of Jesus' disciples?
 - (4) Did Jesus' disciples really understand what He was saying and the impact on them? Explain.
 - (5) Why did Jesus have this talk with His disciples?
 - (6) What do you think was Jesus' "bottom line" in this Scripture passage?
- c. **Application**: How will you apply this Scripture passage in your life?
- (1) **How** has the Holy Spirit worked in your life since accepting Jesus Christ as your Savior? Share your story.
 - (2) **How** do you typically deal with life's difficulties?
 - (3) **How** could you better apply Jesus' teaching in this Scripture passage in your life? Be specific.
- 3. Write out <u>John 16:33</u> from memory.
- 4. Read Acts 2:1-4. Conclude your study time with prayer.

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
