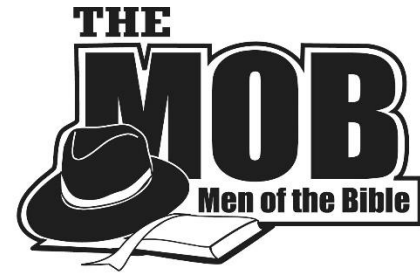

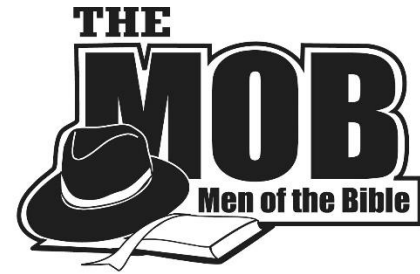

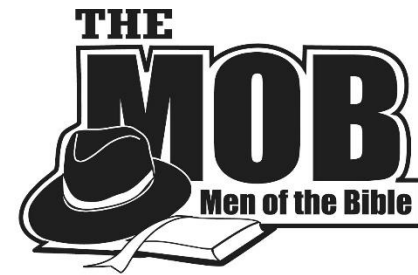
## Revelation 21:3-4 (ESV)

10. What one or two things are you most looking forward to seeing, or doing, when you get to heaven?



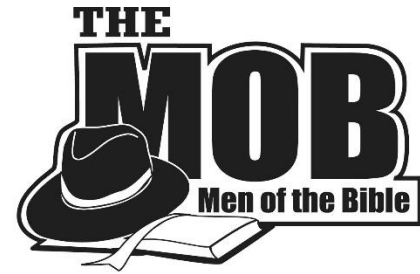

# Dispensations



**Dispensationalism** is a method of interpreting history that divides God’s work and purposes toward mankind into different periods of time.

1. Dispensation of **Innocence** ([Genesis 1:28-30, 2:15-17](#))
2. Dispensation of **Conscience** ([Genesis 3:8 – 8:22](#))
3. Dispensation of **Human Government** ([Genesis 8 – 11](#))
4. Dispensation of **Promise** ([Genesis 12:1 – Exodus 19:25](#))
5. Dispensation of **Law** ([Exodus 19–23](#) through [Jesus’ death](#))
6. Dispensation of **Grace** (New Covenant in Christ’s blood, [Luke 22:20](#); “Age of Grace” or “Church Age”)
- ➔ 7. **Millennial Kingdom** of Christ ([Revelation 20:1-6](#))

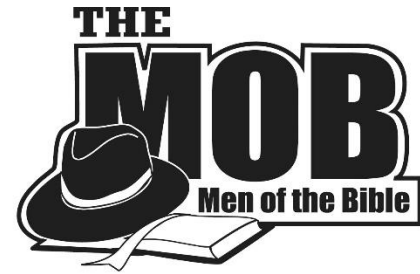

[Romans 8:29-30](#) , [1 Peter 2:9](#), and other passages



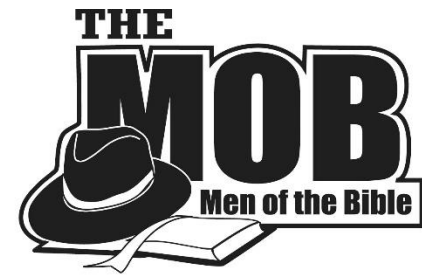
1. Foreknowledge / Predestination / Election  
(God's choice of some unto salvation)
2. Effectual Call (External Gospel Call) / Regeneration  
(Internal Call / New Birth)
3. Conversion (Repentance & Faith)
4. Justification (Declaration of Right Legal Standing)
5. Adoption (Placed into the Family of God)
6. Sanctification (Progressive Growth in Holiness)
7. Perseverance (Remaining in Christ)
-  8. Glorification (Receiving a Resurrection Body)

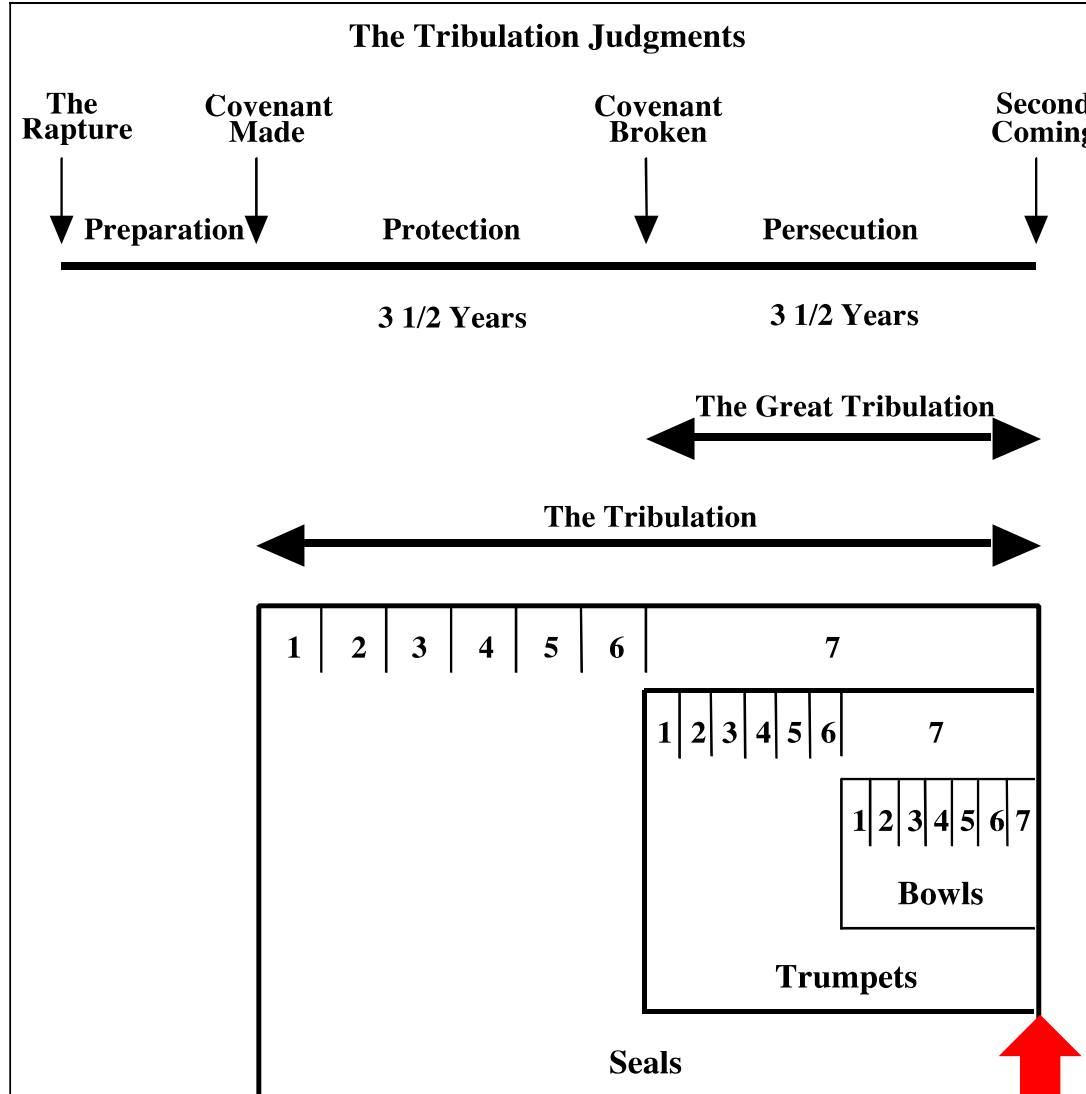
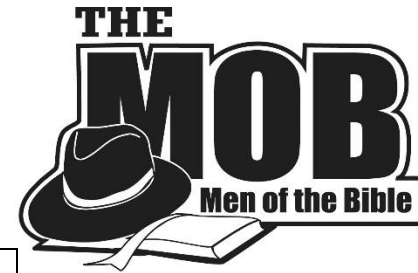
# The Seven Beatitudes of The Revelation



1. **Revelation 1:3** Blessed is the one who reads aloud the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear, and who keep what is written in it, for the time is near.
2. **Revelation 14:13** And I heard a voice from heaven saying, “Write this: Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on.” “Blessed indeed,” says the Spirit, “that they may rest from their labors, for their deeds follow them!”
3. **Revelation 16:15** (“Behold, I am coming like a thief! Blessed is the one who stays awake, keeping his garments on, that he may not go about naked and be seen exposed!”)
4. **Revelation 19:9** And the angel said to me, “Write this: Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb.” And he said to me, “These are the true words of God.”
5. **Revelation 20:6** Blessed and holy is the one who shares in the first resurrection! Over such the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ, and they will reign with him for a thousand years.
6. **Revelation 22:7** “And behold, I am coming soon. Blessed is the one who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book.”
7. **Revelation 22:14** Blessed are those who wash their robes, so that they may have the right to the tree of life and that they may enter the city by the gates. [Jerusalem [Revelation 21:9](#)]
