

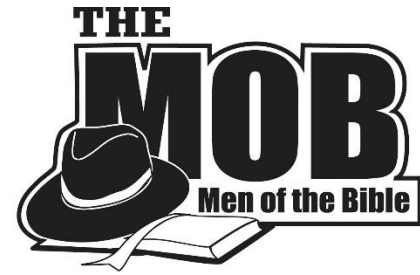

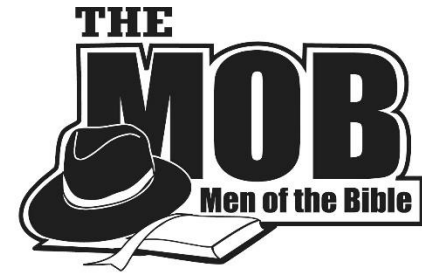

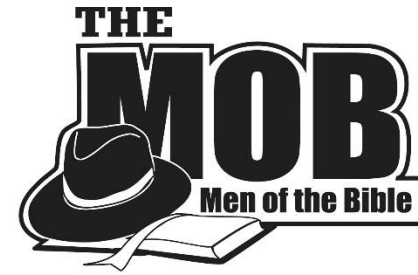

- Engage men in Christian fellowship with other men through Prayer, Bible Study, Worship, Small Group Interaction, and Ministry Activities

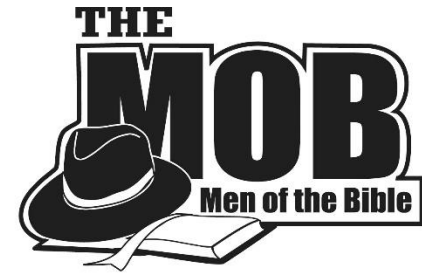

The Holy Bible

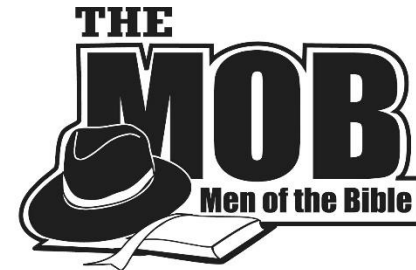

We believe the Scriptures - the 39 books of the Old Testament and 27 books of the New Testament - provide God's authoritative written revelation to mankind ([2 Timothy 3:16-17](#); [1 Thessalonians 2:13](#); [Galatians 1:12](#)). God interacted with the human writers of those books so that every word of the original texts was exactly as He wanted ([2 Peter 1:20-21](#)) and without error ([John 17:17](#)). The Scriptures are the supreme and final authority ([Psalms 19:7-11](#); [Ps 119](#); [Romans 10:17](#); [Hebrews 4:12](#)).

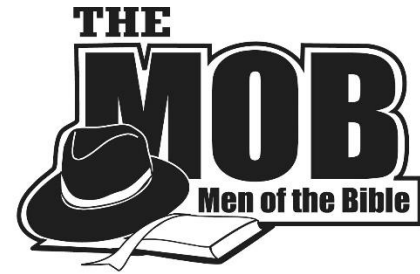

Interpreting Scripture

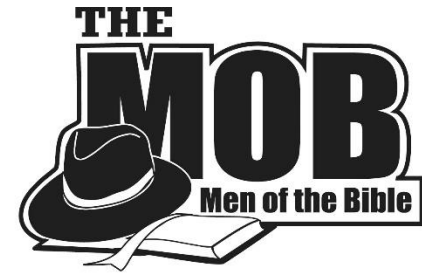
[\(Ref. IBC What We Teach\)](#)



1. **Normal** - understanding the words of Scripture in their common usage unless otherwise indicated by the context.
2. **Literal** - understanding the meaning of Scripture in its ordinary sense unless the context requires a figurative interpretation.
3. **Grammatical** - using the recognized rules of grammar to interpret the text.
4. **Historical** - understanding the words of Scripture in the context of the times in which they were written.
5. **Systematic** - categorizing and comparing the teaching of the Scriptures with the whole of Scripture in view.

Bible Study

- **Individual** – Study (more than just reading) assigned Scripture passages before coming to each MOB meeting [2 Timothy 2:15](#)
- **Large Group** – Listen, take notes, and ask questions
- **Small Group** – Actively participate in your Small Group

Prayer

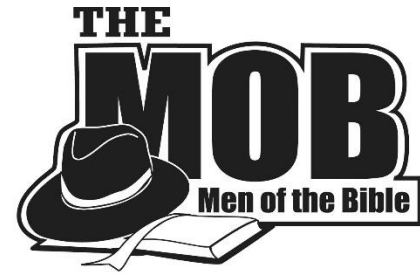
- **Individual** – Pray by yourself “without ceasing” [1 Thess 5:16-18](#)
- **Large Group** – Pray with and for our Large Group
- **Small Group** – Pray with and for your Small Group

Fellowship

- **Large Group** – Fellowship with other men before, during, and after
- **Small Group** – Fellowship with other men before, during, and after, “bearing one another’s burdens” [Galatians 6:2](#)



Code of Confidentiality

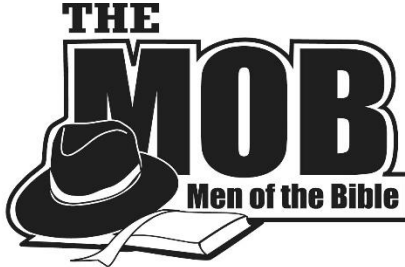


“What is said in the MOB stays in the MOB.”

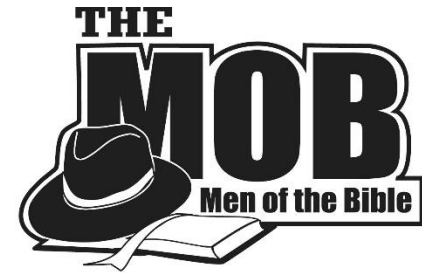

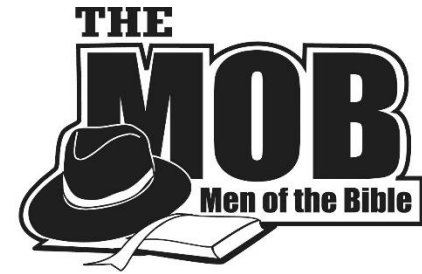
