

Memory Verses for MOB Study of 2 Peter, 2 John, 3 John and Jude

Lesson 1 (November 17, 2015) 2 Peter 1:20-21 (ESV) - knowing this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture comes from someone's own interpretation. For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

Lesson 2 (December 1, 2015) 2 Peter 2:1 (ESV) - But false prophets also arose among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Master who bought them, bringing upon themselves swift destruction.

Lesson 3 (December 15, 2015) 2 Peter 2:21 (ESV) - For it would have been better for them never to have known the way of righteousness than after knowing it to turn back from the holy commandment delivered to them.

Lesson 4 (January 5, 2016) 2 Peter 3:9 (ESV) - The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.

Lesson 5 (January 12, 2016) 2 John 9 (ESV) - Everyone who goes on ahead and does not abide in the teaching of Christ, does not have God. Whoever abides in the teaching has both the Father and the Son.

Lesson 6 (January 19, 2016) 3 John 3 (ESV) - For I rejoiced greatly when the brothers came and testified to your truth, as indeed you are walking in the truth.

Lesson 7 - (February 2, 2016) Jude 3 (ESV) - Beloved, although I was very eager to write to you about our common salvation, I found it necessary to write appealing to you to contend for the faith that was once for all delivered to the saints.

Lesson 8 (February 9, 2016) Jude 20-21 (ESV) - But you, beloved, building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the Holy Spirit, keep yourselves in the love of God, waiting for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ that leads to eternal life.

Lesson 9 (February 16, 2016) Jude 24-25 (ESV) - Now to him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you blameless before the presence of his glory with great joy, to the only God, our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion, and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen.
