

Lesson 1 2 Timothy 3:16-17 All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness; so that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

Lesson 2 John 1:1-5 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him was not anything made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men. The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

Lesson 3 Matthew 19:4-6 He (Jesus) answered, “Have you not read that He who created them from the beginning made them male and female and said, ‘Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh’? So they are no longer two, but one flesh? What therefore God has joined together, let no man separate.”

Lesson 4 Genesis 3:15 “And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring; He shall bruise you on the head, and you shall bruise him on the heel.”

Lesson 5 Romans 5:18-19 Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for all men, so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all men. For as by one man’s disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the one man’s obedience the many will be made righteous.

Lesson 6 Hebrews 11:7 By faith Noah, being warned by God concerning events as yet unseen, in reverent fear constructed an ark for the saving of his household. By this he condemned the world, and became an heir of the righteousness that comes by faith.

Lesson 7 Genesis 11:7-9 “Come, let us go down and there confuse their language, so that they will not understand one another’s speech.” So the Lord dispersed them from there over the face of all the earth, and they left off building the city. Therefore its name was called Babel, because there the Lord confused the language of all the earth. And from there the Lord dispersed them abroad over the face of all the earth.

Lesson 8 Genesis 12:1-3 Now the Lord said to Abram, “Go forth from your country, and from your kindred and your father’s house to the land that I will show you. And I will make you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”

Lesson 9 Psalm 110:4 The Lord has sworn and will not change His mind. You are a priest forever after the order of Melchizedek.

Lesson 10 Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon His shoulders, and His name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Lesson 11 Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in the Lord with all your heart and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make straight your paths.

Lesson 12 Genesis 17:7-8 And I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your offspring after you throughout their generation for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and to your offspring after you. And I will give to you and to your offspring after you, the land of your sojournings, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession; and I will be their God.

Lesson 13 2 Peter 2:7-9 And if He (God) rescued Lot, greatly distressed by the sensual conduct of the wicked (for as that righteous man lived among them day after day, he was tormenting his righteous soul over their lawless deeds that he saw and heard); then the Lord knows how to rescue the godly from trials, and to keep the unrighteous under punishment until the day of judgment, and especially those who indulge in the lust of defiling passion and despise authority.

Lesson 14 Galatians 4:4-5 But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law, to redeem those who were under the Law, so that we might receive adoption as sons.

Lesson 15 Romans 4:3 For what does the Scripture say? “Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness.”

Lesson 16 Proverbs 31:30-31 Charm is deceitful and beauty is vain, but a woman who fears the Lord is to be praised.

Lesson 17 Psalm 116:15 Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of His godly ones.

Lesson 18 Jeremiah 17:9 The heart is deceitful above all things and is desperately sick; who can understand it?

Lesson 19 Psalm 133:1 Behold, how good and how pleasant it is when brothers dwell in unity.

Lesson 20 Isaiah 40:26 Lift up your eyes on high and see who created these (stars)? He who brings out their host by number, calling them all by name; by the greatness of His might and because he is strong in power, not one is missing.

Lesson 21 Genesis 31:49 And Mizpah, for he said, “The Lord watch between you and me when we are out of one another’s sight.”

Lesson 22 Psalm 46:10-11 Be still and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth.

Lesson 23 2 Corinthians 6:14-16 Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers; for what partnership has righteousness and lawlessness? Or what fellowship has light with darkness? What accord has Christ with Belial? Or what portion does a believer share with an unbeliever? What agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; as God said, "I will make my dwelling among them and walk among them; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people."

Lesson 24 Isaiah 45:4 For the sake of My servant Jacob, and Israel My chosen, I call you by your name; I have named you, though you have not known Me.

Lesson 25 Psalm 37:23-24 The steps of a good man are established by the Lord, when he delights in his way; though he fall, he shall not be cast headlong, for the Lord upholds his hand.

Lesson 26 1 Peter 2:9-10 But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

Lesson 27 Isaiah 41:10 Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.

Lesson 28 Jeremiah 32:17 Ah Lord God. It is you who have made the heavens and the earth by your great power and by Your outstretched arm. Nothing is too hard for you.

Lesson 29 Psalm 27:13-14 I would have despaired unless I had believed that I would see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living. Wait for the Lord; be strong and let your heart take courage; yes, wait for the Lord.

Lesson 30 Romans 8:28 And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to His purpose.

Lesson 31 Psalm 90:1-2 Lord, you have been our dwelling place in all generations. Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever you had formed the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting, you are God.
