

Lesson 1 Isaiah 52:7 How lovely on the mountains are the feet of him who brings good news, who announces peace and brings good news of happiness, who announces salvation, and says to Zion, “Your God reigns!”

Lesson 2 2 Peter 1:20-21 But know first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture is a matter of one’s own interpretation, for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.

Lesson 3 2 Timothy 2:15 Be diligent to present yourself approved of God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the Word of Truth.

Lesson 4 2 Timothy 3:16-17 All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for very good work.

Lesson 5 Romans 1:16-17 For I am not ashamed of the Gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, “But the righteous shall live by faith.”

Lesson 6 Romans 1:18-20 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, because that which is known about God is evident to them. For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse.

Lesson 7 Hebrews 10:1 For the Law, since it has only a shadow of the good things to come and not the very form of things, can never, by the same sacrifices which they offer constantly year by year, make perfect those who draw near.

Lesson 8 Ephesians 2:8-9 For by grace you have been saved through faith and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

Lesson 9 Romans 3:10 As it is written, “There is none righteous, not even one;”

Lesson 10 Romans 3:23 For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

Lesson 11 Hebrews 11:6 And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.

Lesson 12 Romans 4:3 For what does the Scripture say? Abraham believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness.

Lesson 13 Romans 5:1 Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Lesson 14 Romans 6:11 Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus.

Lesson 15 Galatians 3:24 Therefore, the Law has become our tutor (schoolmaster) to lead us to Christ, so that we may be justified by faith.

Lesson 16 Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

Lesson 17 Romans 8:16 The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him.

Lesson 18 Romans 8:28 And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose.

Lesson 19 Romans 9:16 So then it does not depend on the man who wills or the man who runs, but on God who has mercy.

Lesson 20 Romans 10:17 So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.

Lesson 21 Romans 11:33 Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God. How unsearchable are His judgments and unfathomable His ways.

Lesson 22 Romans 12:1-2 Therefore, I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

Lesson 23 Romans 12:9 Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good.

Lesson 24 Romans 13:1-2 Every person is to be in subjection to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those which exist are established by God. Therefore, whoever resists authority has opposed the ordinance of God; and they who have opposed will receive condemnation upon themselves.

Lesson 25 Romans 13:8 Owe nothing to anyone except to love one another; for he who loves his neighbor has fulfilled the law.

Lesson 26 Romans 14:12 So then each one of us will give an account of himself to God.

Lesson 27 Romans 15:13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you will abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Lesson 28 Romans 16:25-27 Now to Him who is able to establish you according to my gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery which has been kept secret for long ages past, but now is manifested, and by the Scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the eternal God, has been made known to all the nations, leading to obedience of faith; to the only wise God, through Jesus Christ, be the glory forever. Amen.
