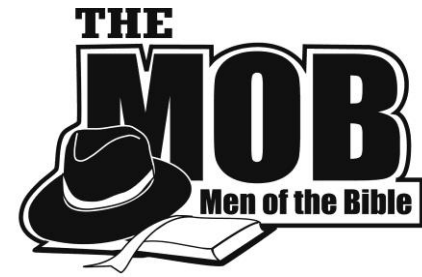

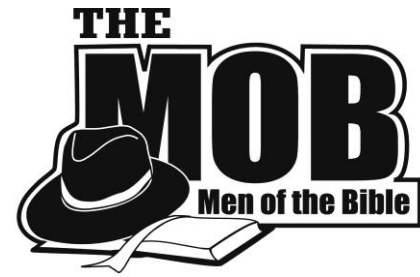

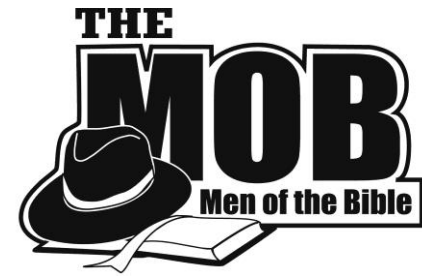

- Engage men in Christian fellowship with other men through Prayer, Bible Study, Worship, Small Group Interaction, and Ministry Activities

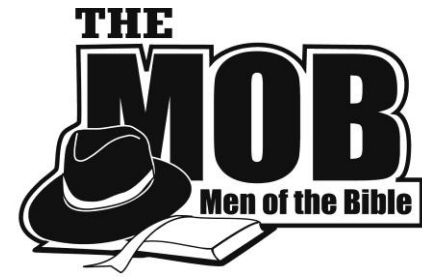
CORE COMPETENCIES

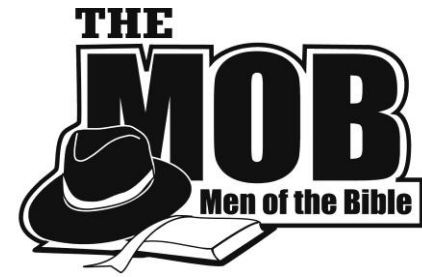

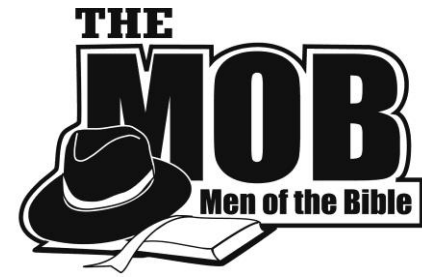

Code of Confidentiality

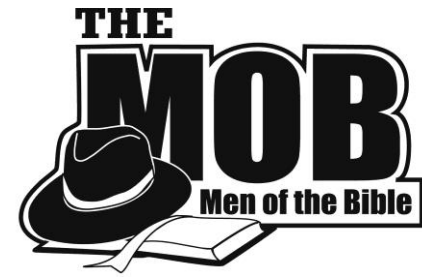


“What is said in the MOB stays in the MOB.”

- This means that you may NOT share any information that another brother might share in the MOB without first getting his permission in advance. This is important for building healthy, strong, lasting relationships.



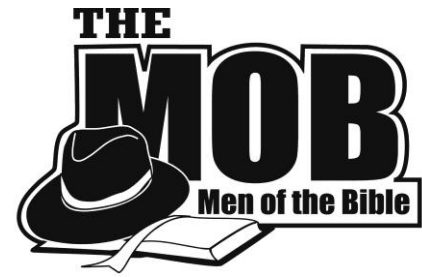
