**Lesson #2 (I Corinthians 1:1-9—September 10, 2024)—“God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.” (1 Corinthians 1:9)**

**Lesson #3 (I Corinthians 1:10-17—September 17, 2024)—“For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel, and not with words of eloquent wisdom, lest the cross of Christ be emptied of its power!” (I Corinthians 1:17)**

**Lesson #4 (I Corinthians 1:18-31—September 24, 2024)—“For the word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.” (1 Corinthians 1:18)**

**Lesson #5 (I Corinthians 2:1-16—October 1, 2024) “Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might understand the things freely given us by God.”-(I Corinthians 2:12)**

**Lesson #6 (I Corinthians 3:1-15—October 8, 2004) “For no one can lay a foundation other than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.” (1 Corinthians 3:11)**

**Lesson # 7 (I Corinthians 3:16-23—October 15, 2024) “For the wisdom of this world is folly with God. For it is written, ‘He catches the wise in their craftiness,’ and again, ‘The Lord knows the thoughts of the wise, that they are futile.’”(I Corinthians 3:19-20)**

**Lesson #8 (I Corinthians 4-1-21—October 23, 2024) “Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found faithful.” (I Corinthians 4:2)**

**Lesson #9 (I Corinthians 5:1-13—October 29, 2024) “Your boasting is not good! Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump?” (I Corinthians 5:6)**

**Lesson #10 (I Corinthians 6:1-11—November 5, 2024) “Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived: neither the sexually immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor men who practice homosexuality, nor thieves, nor the greedy, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God.” (I Corinthians 6:9-10)**

**Lesson #11 (I Corinthians 6:12-20—November 12, 2024) “Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.” (I Corinthians 6:19-20)**

**Lesson #12 (I Corinthians 7:1-16—November 19, 2024) “For the unbelieving husband is made holy because of his wife, and the unbelieving wife is made holy because of her husband. Otherwise your children would be unclean, but as it is, they are holy!” (I Corinthians 7:14)**

**Lesson #13 (I Corinthians 7:17-24—December 3, 2024) “For he who was called in the Lord as a bondservant is a freedman of the Lord. Likewise he who was free when called is a bondservant of Christ.” (I Corinthians 7:22)**

**Lesson #14 (I Corinthians 7:26-40—December 10, 2024) “So then he who marries his betrothed does well, and he who refrains from marriage will do even better.” (I Corinthians 7:38)**

**Lesson #15 (I Corinthians 8:1-13—December 17, 2024) “But take care that this right of yours does not somehow become a stumbling block to the weak!” (I Corinthians 8:9)**

**Lesson #16 (I Corinthians 9:1-18—January 7, 2025) “For if I preach the gospel, that gives me no ground for boasting. For necessity is laid upon me. Woe to me if I do not preach the gospel!” (I Corinthians 9:16)**

**Lesson #17 (I Corinthians 9:19-27—January 14, 2025) “To the weak I became weak, that I might win the weak! I have become all things to all people, that by all means I might save some!” (I Corinthians 9:22)**

**Lesson #18 (I Corinthians 10:1-13—January 21, 2005) “No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and He will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation He will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it!” (I Corinthians 10:13)**

**Lesson #19 (I Corinthians 10:14-11:1—January 28, 2025) “So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God!” (I Corinthians 10:31)**

**Lesson #20 (I Corinthians 11:2-16—February 4, 2025) “But I want you to understand that the head of every man is Christ, the head of every wife is her husband, and the head of Christ is God!” (I Corinthians 11:3)**

**Lesson #21 (I Corinthians 11:17-34—February 11, 2025) “Let a person examine himself, then, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the body eats and drinks judgment on himself.” (I Corinthians 11:28-29)**

**Lesson #22 (I Corinthians 12:1-11—February 18, 2035) “Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who empowers them all in everyone.” (I Corinthians 12:4-6)**

**Lesson #23 (I Corinthians 12:12-31—February 25, 2035) “If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together!” (I Corinthians 12:26)**

**Lesson #24 (I Corinthians 13:1-13—March 4, 2025) “And if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge, and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing!” (I Corinthians 13:2)**

**Lesson #25 (I Corinthians 14:1-12—March 11, 2025) “Pursue love, and earnestly desire the spiritual gifts, especially that you may prophesy!” (I Corinthians 14:1)**

**Lesson #26 (I Corinthians 14:13-25—March 18, 2025) “Thus tongues are a sign not for believers but for unbelievers, while prophecy is a sign for unbelievers but for believers!” (I Corinthians 14:22)**

**Lesson #27 (I Corinthians 14:26-40)—March 25, 2025) “But all things should be done decently and in order!” (I Corinthians 14:40)**

**Lesson #28 (I Corinthians 15:1-19—April 1, 2025) “For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures.” (I Corinthians 15:3-4)**

**Lesson #29 (I Corinthians 15:20-34—April 8, 2025) “For as by a man came death, by a man has come also the resurrection from the dead!” (I Corinthians 15:21)**

**Lesson #30 (I Corinthians 15:35-45—April 22, 2025) “Just as we have borne the image of the dust, we shall also bear the man of heaven!” (I Corinthians 15:45)**

**Lesson #31 (I Corinthians 15:46-58—April 29, 2025) “Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain!” (I Corinthians 15:58)**
