<b>September 12, 2023</b>	<b>Isaiah 40:8</b>	The grass withers, the flower fades, But the word of our God stands forever.
<b>September 19, 2023</b>	<b>Isaiah 40:31</b>	Yet those who wait for the LORD Will gain new strength; They will mount up with wings like eagles, They will run and not get tired, They will walk and not become weary.
<b>September 26, 2023</b>	<b>Isaiah 41:10</b>	‘Do not fear, for I am with you; Do not anxiously look about you, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, surely I will help you, Surely I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.’
<b>October 3, 2023</b>	<b>Isaiah 41:23–24</b>	23 Declare the things that are going to come afterward, That we may know that you are gods; Indeed, do good or evil, that we may anxiously look about us and fear together. 24 Behold, you are of no account, And your work amounts to nothing; He who chooses you is an abomination.
<b>October 10, 2023</b>	<b>Isaiah 42:8</b>	“I am the LORD, that is My name; I will not give My glory to another, Nor My praise to graven images.
<b>October 17, 2023</b>	<b>Isaiah 42:20</b>	You have seen many things, but you do not observe them; Your ears are open, but none hears.
<b>October 24, 2023</b>	<b>Isaiah 43:10</b>	“You are My witnesses,” declares the LORD, “And My servant whom I have chosen, So that you may know and believe Me And understand that I am He. Before Me there was no God formed, And there will be none after Me.
<b>October 31, 2023</b>	<b>Isaiah 44:6</b>	“Thus says the LORD, the King of Israel and his Redeemer, the LORD of hosts: ‘I am the first and I am the last, And there is no God besides Me.
<b>November 7, 2023</b>	<b>Isaiah 45:8</b>	“Drip down, O heavens, from above, And let the clouds pour down righteousness; Let the earth open up and salvation bear fruit, And righteousness spring up with it. I, the LORD, have created it.
<b>November 14, 2023</b>	<b>Isaiah 46:9–10</b>	9 “Remember the former things long past, For I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is no one like Me, 10 Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times things which have not been done, Saying, ‘My purpose will be established, And I will accomplish all My good pleasure’;

<b>November 28, 2023</b>	<b>Isaiah 47:10</b>	“You felt secure in your wickedness and said, ‘No one sees me,’ Your wisdom and your knowledge, they have deluded you; For you have said in your heart, ‘I am, and there is no one besides me.’
<b>December 5, 2023</b>	<b>Isaiah 48:10–11</b>	10 “Behold, I have refined you, but not as silver; I have tested you in the furnace of affliction. 11 “For My own sake, for My own sake, I will act; For how can My name be profaned? And My glory I will not give to another.
<b>December 12, 2023</b>	<b>Isaiah 49:13</b>	Shout for joy, O heavens! And rejoice, O earth! Break forth into joyful shouting, O mountains! For the LORD has comforted His people And will have compassion on His afflicted.
<b>January 2, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 50:4</b>	The Lord GOD has given Me the tongue of disciples, That I may know how to sustain the weary one with a word. He awakens Me morning by morning, He awakens My ear to listen as a disciple.
<b>January 9, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 51:11</b>	So the ransomed of the LORD will return And come with joyful shouting to Zion, And everlasting joy will be on their heads. They will obtain gladness and joy, And sorrow and sighing will flee away.
<b>January 16, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 52:7</b>	How lovely on the mountains Are the feet of him who brings good news, Who announces peace And brings good news of happiness, Who announces salvation, And says to Zion, “Your God reigns!”
<b>January 23, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 52:15</b>	Thus He will sprinkle many nations, Kings will shut their mouths on account of Him; For what had not been told them they will see, And what they had not heard they will understand.
<b>January 30, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 53:3–4</b>	3 He was despised and forsaken of men, A man of sorrows and acquainted with grief; And like one from whom men hide their face He was despised, and we did not esteem Him. 4 Surely our griefs He Himself bore, And our sorrows He carried; Yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken, Smitten of God, and afflicted.

<b>February 6, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 53:11</b>	As a result of the anguish of His soul, He will see it and be satisfied; By His knowledge the Righteous One, My Servant, will justify the many, As He will bear their iniquities.
<b>February 13, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 54:10</b>	“For the mountains may be removed and the hills may shake, But My lovingkindness will not be removed from you, And My covenant of peace will not be shaken,” Says the LORD who has compassion on you.
<b>February 20, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 55:3</b>	“Incline your ear and come to Me. Listen, that you may live; And I will make an everlasting covenant with you, According to the faithful mercies shown to David.
<b>February 27, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 56:7</b>	Even those I will bring to My holy mountain And make them joyful in My house of prayer. Their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be acceptable on My altar; For My house will be called a house of prayer for all the peoples.”
<b>March 5, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 57:20</b>	But the wicked are like the tossing sea, For it cannot be quiet, And its waters toss up refuse and mud.
<b>March 12, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 58:5</b>	“Is it a fast like this which I choose, a day for a man to humble himself? Is it for bowing one’s head like a reed And for spreading out sackcloth and ashes as a bed? Will you call this a fast, even an acceptable day to the LORD?
<b>March 19, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 59:1–2</b>	1 Behold, the LORD’S hand is not so short That it cannot save; Nor is His ear so dull That it cannot hear. 2 But your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, And your sins have hidden His face from you so that He does not hear.
<b>March 26, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 60:12</b>	“For the nation and the kingdom which will not serve you will perish, And the nations will be utterly ruined.
<b>April 9, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 61:1–2</b>	1 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me, Because the LORD has anointed me To bring good news to the afflicted; He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to captives And freedom to prisoners; 2 To proclaim the favorable year of the LORD And the day of vengeance of our God; To comfort all who mourn,

<b>April 16, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 62:4</b>	It will no longer be said to you, "Forsaken," Nor to your land will it any longer be said, "Desolate"; But you will be called, "My delight is in her," And your land, "Married"; For the LORD delights in you, And to Him your land will be married.
<b>April 23, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 63:7</b>	I shall make mention of the lovingkindnesses of the LORD, the praises of the LORD, According to all that the LORD has granted us, And the great goodness toward the house of Israel, Which He has granted them according to His compassion And according to the abundance of His lovingkindnesses.
<b>April 30, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 64:4</b>	For from days of old they have not heard or perceived by ear, Nor has the eye seen a God besides You, Who acts in behalf of the one who waits for Him.
<b>May 7, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 65:1</b>	"I permitted Myself to be sought by those who did not ask for Me; I permitted Myself to be found by those who did not seek Me. I said, 'Here am I, here am I,' To a nation which did not call on My name.
<b>May 14, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 66:1</b>	Thus says the LORD, "Heaven is My throne and the earth is My footstool. Where then is a house you could build for Me? And where is a place that I may rest?"
<b>May 21, 2024</b>	<b>Isaiah 53:6</b>	All of us like sheep have gone astray, Each of us has turned to his own way; But the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all To fall on Him.
